

Proposal Review Criteria for the 11th JURE Conference, Leuven, Belgium (2008)

Your proposal will be judged by at least two JURE 2008 committee members. For acceptance your proposal should fulfill at least five out of the seven following criteria:

1. Research in the field of learning and instruction (necessary requirement)
2. Clear theoretical grounding of the research
3. Clear definition of the research question
4. Clarity of the research design (participants – conditions – research context – variables, etc)
5. Clarity of (planned) methodology (data collection, instruments and analyses, etc)
6. Presence of a critical reflection (on the research topic, research questions, design, methodology, relevance or results)
7. Significance for educational practice and/or theory development in the field of education and/or educational policy
